Background

Members are aware of the multi-agency 'Gorwel' data sharing platform, which is in the process of being developed. This system will assist with the identification, collection and analysis of qualitative and quantitative data to support the work of the PSBs, aiding the development of the Well-being Assessments and inform the progress of the Well-being Plans.

As previously advised, Neil Coetzee was appointed as Regional Data Co-Ordinator in September 2023 in a role which is funded to end of March 2026 using the Welsh Government funding available to PSB regions. The regional role leads on the continued development of 'Gorwel'. Initial work has focused on liaising with the development team at Write Media on the progress made to date.

Next steps

- Work on national datasets to be made available on the platform and accessed by partners
- Ensure the functionality of the site is user-friendly, with dashboards and data displayed in an easy to use format
- Enable the exporting of data outside of the platform to be used by partners
- Work on the involvement side of the platform to allow partners to share local sources of information, reports, updates on projects and engagement undertaken. This will assist in raising awareness, highlighting collaborative opportunities and reduce duplication
- Introduce a "My Work" section to allow users to see their individual workload and sections they have contributed to and be notified of any updates or changes to their pieces of work on the platform
- Work on user access usernames, password management/reset, platform roles and distribution of site access
- Develop user training/familiarisation on the platform with supporting documentation.
